Sports Premium Funding

At Radnage, we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the Children. We believe that a varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence in the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all our children.

Our Primary School Sport's Funding will enable us to continue and extend our provisions through employing additional sports professionals, entering into more competitive sports competitions and training our staff to deliver in-house quality PE lessons.

What is the Sports Premium?

Each school will receive £8000 plus an extra £5 per pupil each year for the next two years. From January 2015 Census this means £8325 for 2015-16. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

Uses of the Funding include:

- Hiring specialist qualified sports coaches to work alongside teachers when teaching
 PE. This has included hockey, dance and Gymnastic coaches costing £7020
- New lunchtime sports clubs and Young Leaders playground games costing £5570
- Buying additional equipment for PE/Sport cost £200. The school meets the extra funding costs

Impact

- The additional funding is used to make improvements in PE and sports for our children
- The number of lunch clubs has increased and higher numbers of children have participated in one or more of these clubs during the year.
- The profile of PE across the school has been raised, higher participation and enhanced skills progression.
